Summary Board of Directors Election Process

Nomination Process: Candidates may be nominated by others, or candidates may nominate themselves if they have an interest in a Board position, by filling out and submitting a Board of Directors Nomination Form. The form must be received at the Grand Forks Park District office no later than 4:00 PM on Tuesday, February 21 to have a nominee's name listed on the ballot. Write-in or last-minute nominations are allowed at the Annual Meeting on February 29, 2012, but write-in or last-minute nominations will require write-in votes on the ballot as the write-in or last-minute nominee's name will not be listed on the ballot.

Election: Ballots will be distributed, and the election will take place, at the February 29, 2012 Annual Meeting. George Hellyer, The Grand Park District's Chief Operating Officer will be the person brought in to act as an election clerk for the Association.

Counting the Ballots: The ballots will be counted at the February 29, 2012 Annual Meeting.
