What an amazing year - thanks to all our generous donors and visionary supporters!

After much-anticipation, Phase 1 of the new Skatepark at Kannowski Park was officially opened to the public on September 23, 2018. Families and skate enthusiasts alike joined the Grand Forks Park District and members of the Skatepark Committee for an open skate and ribbon cutting ceremony celebrating the Rydell Skatepark. We are blessed to have the support of the public and skating enthusiasts.

From the continuous pledged commitment of the Building Fields of Dreams Campaign supporters, all four diamonds at Scheels Sports Complex were used by Cal Ripken 9 & 10 year-old league, Cal Ripken 11 & 12 year-old league, and all Forks Area Youth Baseball travel teams 9-12 years old in the 2018 season! Also in 2018, we poured concrete pads for dugouts on diamond 3 & 4; extended the sidewalk entrance; ran power to the scoreboards for operation; installed building signage; and completed the main facility monument signage.

With 535 games (805+ hours of ice time), 10+ youth hockey invitational tournaments, and hours of ice time rented in 2018 totaling over 3,475 hours, ICON Sports Center continues to be full year-round.

Through the support of our strong partnerships and the unyielding commitment of our generous IMAGINE Campaign donors, Choice Health & Fitness continues to serve our loyal members, visitors, and the Grand Forks region. In 2018, Choice Health & Fitness registered over 370,000 member visits.

Lastly, we are thrilled to report that it was another successful year for the Grand Forks Veterans Memorial Park campaign! Approximately \$500,000 has been raised in 2018 for the Grand Forks Memorial Park and since the beginning of our campaign, 475+ Memorial Stones have been sold. As construction on the park continues, we hope to host a Grand Opening event in 2019.

Thank you for helping us promote healthy lifestyles through amazing facilities and great programs that enhance the quality of life for our Grand Forks community.

# RYDELL SKATEPARK

*grand opening* 

SEPTEMBER 23, 2018

After a much-anticipated wait, Phase 1 of the new skatepark in Grand Forks was officially opened to the public Sunday, September 23. Families and skate enthusiasts alike joined the Grand Forks Park District and members of the Skatepark Committee for an open skate and ribbon cutting ceremony celebrating the Rydell Skatepark located at Kannowski Park.

The excitement of the new facility drew in a large crowd, sporting everything from skateboards and scooters, to BMX bikes and inline skates. Even after the celebration, people of all ages have been busy using the Rydell Skatepark every night since it opened, something those closely involved in the project's creation are elated about: "It's just been fun to see how many people are going to the park." said Brian Rydell, whose car dealership donated \$100,538 to the project. "It's attracting a lot of folks to be out of their house and just be active." Skaters and their families now have a safe place to gather and hone their skills.

**Phase 1 Features:** The relocation of features of the old skatepark, located down town next to the Police Station, to the new location at Kannowski Park, the park is beginning to take shape. Features from the previous location including the Tri-Tiered Manual Pad, Grind Ledge, and HSS Grind Rail have been moved and will be incorporated into the new park's design. In addition to the relocated sections of the park, the new skatepark has eighteen new features of varying structures, levels, and obstacles. The main feature of the park consists of a large Radius Bowl, complete with walls and features surrounding it.

The Park District, along with the Skatepark Committee, are currently working on raising the funds needed to construct and complete Phase 2 of the project. Naming opportunities for skatepark features are still available, as well as places in the "Friends of the Park" and "Skater Friends" donation gift clubs. With the Forks Area Baseball League operating out of Scheels Sports Complex, the fields are full Mondays through Thursdays with Cal Ripken Baseball 9 & 10 year old and Cal Ripken Baseball 11 & 12 year-old league games during the summer. In 2018, we also had five traveling Cal Ripken teams practice and play games at Scheels Sports Complex. Another addition in 2018 was the implementation of a new fall baseball league, in effort to extend the baseball season into September for youth players.

# HONORING OUR *veterans* VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK



The Veterans Memorial Committee is honored to report on another successful year for the campaign project, with many significant advancements made!

EAPC Architects Engineers finished their design work, and AE2S Advanced Engineering and Environmental Services completed their Site Survey. The sidewalk from the parking lot around the USS Kiska Anchor and down to 24th Ave S has been placed. Standardized signage has been selected and the first sign will be for the Anchor. Signs will be placed on bases provided by Wells Concrete.

The City Council approved unanimously to ceremonially name portions of 24th Ave S and S 34th St "Veterans Memorial Parkway". The General Contractor, Opp Construction, has completed the footings and foundation for the Granite Wall and the five Military Service Obelisks. JLG Architects has designed the Veterans Memorial Park Donor Recognition Wall for donors of \$1,000 or more.

Gary Shields, our volunteer professional fund raiser and Board member, along with Chair Al Palmer and Board member Mike Hagen, have reached out to more agencies and greatly increased community awareness and support.

Major donors include the Engelstad Family Foundation, Rydell Auto Center, Red River Valley Motorcyclists, Disabled American Veterans Chapter 2, General Atomics, Joe Neel Jr, and Strata Corporation. Approximately \$500,000 has been raised in 2018 for the Grand Forks Veterans Memorial Park and since the beginning of our campaign, 475+ memorial stones have been sold.

Through community philanthropy and the efforts of supporters, the campaign committee will design, execute, and conduct a fundraising campaign to raise the necessary dollars to create and build a Veterans Memorial Park, this six-acre site, located NW of the Columbia Mall and adjacent to the roundabout at 24th Ave. S. and 34th St., into existence. It will be an outdoor gathering place for veterans, military members, families and the community to celebrate, recognize, remember, and honor the lives of those who are serving or have served in the U.S. Military.
