Community Relations & Marketing Manager Nelson reported that the fall/winter recreation guide was mailed to all Grand Forks residents. Nelson then updated the Board on the various events and promotions.

Palmiscno updated the Board on the Bringewatt Park volleyball courts renovation, the new shop building at Apollo Complex, and the installation of five shelters at Veterans Memorial Park. Palmiscno also informed the Board that Eagles Arena upgrade is on schedule.
