COMMUNITY GARDENS

WEEDS

Please keep your garden free of weeds – this includes the area outside of fences too. *Please weed up to the first few inches into the aisles*. We'll get the rest.

Overgrown gardens will be given one warning and then tilled over if not addressed in a timely manner.

PLANT WASTE

Please dump all plant debris into the on-site wheelbarrows we will provide. On the map, you will find the three wheelbarrow dump sites marked with a star \mathcal{N} .

WATER

Water spigots are located between garden plots gardens. A Y-connection will be at each garden, please do not remove them. You are responsible for bringing your own hose. Please keep your hoses within your gardens. The district mows the pathways and is not responsible for damage to personal hoses if they are left within the pathways. Please report any irrigation leaks as soon as possible!

If you install fencing within 18 inches of the aisle, please do not drive stakes deeper than 18 inches. It may damage the underground irrigation lines.

GARDEN GATE

There is now a combination lock at the new gate to the gardens. You will be given the combination to the lock once your plot has been paid for. Please remember to lock the gate when you leave.
