

Mancana Manchurian Ash Fraxinus mandshurica 'Mancana' Oleaceae

Description

The Mancana Ash is a male tree, so it will not produce seeds in the fall. The new, young branches are yellow in color. After the leaves fall in autumn, they can be seen vividly against winter snow and skies, making for great, low maintenance winter interest.
