

Fallgold Black Ash

Fraxinus nigra 'Fallgold'
Oleaceae

Description

Fallgold Black Ash is a standard, low maintenance shade tree. It requires little pruning and is fairly resistant to disease. This variety has a tight, round habit and a beautiful golden color in the fall. Perfect for along streets or to provide shade in yards. This variety is grafted onto a Green Ash rootstock for hardiness. However, it can still do poorly over winter.
