

Vanguard Crabapple Malus 'Vanguard' Rosaceae

Description

Vanguard Crabapple is a beautiful ornamental specimen that blooms a fragrant, pink in the spring followed by bronze-green foliage in the summer. Fruits are edible, though tart, and can be used to make jellies, jams, and ciders.
