

Robusta Poplar Populus deltoides 'Robusta' Salicaceae

Description

Robusta Poplar is generally sold as a seedless cottonwood. Its leaves are similar to that of a Plains Cottonwood and it has a similar spread, though will not reach the same size. It does have an aggressive root system, so it's recommended to not plant near buildings. It is, however, good as a fast growing shade tree.
