

PUBLIC SKATING RULES



Skating involves inherent risks, all skaters are responsible for their own safety while using the facility.

The Grand Forks Park District maintains a zero-tolerance policy for disrespectful or abusive behavior towards guests or staff. Swearing, vandalism, fighting, and the possession or use of alcohol or drugs are strictly prohibited.

Staff reserve the right to remove any individual for unsafe actions or failure to follow facility rules.

The Grand Forks Park District is not responsible for lost or stolen items.



Entry onto the ice is prohibited until the Zamboni doors have fully closed and staff have officially reopened the rink.



Do not carry children or items such as phones, cameras, bags, or headphones on the ice.



Hockey sticks and pucks are not allowed during Open Skate.



Tag, racing, crack-the-whip, and similar games are prohibited.



High-level freestyle moves, high kicks, jumps, spins, and spraying ice at others are not allowed.



Individuals are not permitted on the ice surface unless they are wearing skates.



Do not chip, gouge, or damage the ice with skates.



No intentional sliding; get up promptly after a fall.



No throwing snow or objects.



No food or drinks on the ice.
